How Many Children May a Family Day Care Provider Care For?

- There must be one caregiver present for every two children under the age of two.
- School-age children can fill any slot up to the total capacity permitted (8) for Family Day Care.

































































How Many Children May a Group Family Day Care Provider Care For?

- There must be at least one caregiver present for every two children under the age of two.
- · A provider or assistant alone may care for up to six children when none of the children are school-age.

Under 2 Years





- A provider or assistant alone may care for seven children when one of the children is school-age.
- A provider or assistant alone may care for up to eight children when at least two children are school-age.
- School-age children can fill any slot up to the total capacity permitted (16) for Group Family Day Care.
- A provider and assistant(s) may care for any combination of age groups up to a total of 12 children plus four school-age children.
